Dear Colleague,

The Community-Campus Partnerships for Health (CCPH) Board of Directors is recruiting new board members. Applications are due **January 19, 2018**.

We are searching for individuals from a wide variety of academic and organizational backgrounds, with a broad range of experience and expertise, a passion for community-campus partnerships as a strategy for social justice and the time and ability to contribute to an active board. We are particularly looking for people who have experience a) in the business and philanthropic sectors, b) with financial planning and/or fundraising, c) policy and advocacy, as well as d) with dismantling structural inequality.

At the beginning of every CCPH board meeting agenda, we remind ourselves that our job is to lead, to be spokespersons for meaningful values, to model bigness of spirit, to be a powerful conscience of our constituents, and ultimately to see that tomorrow is created in a better image.” As such, the CCPH board’s role includes:

- Determining the mission, values and outcomes that CCPH is striving to achieve
- Monitoring the extent to which CCPH is achieving our mission, values and outcomes
- Ensuring that CCPH is accountable to our members and other key constituents
- Serving as ambassadors for CCPH

The CCPH board meets monthly by phone for 60-90 minutes and one to two times/year in person in different locations in the US. Being able to pay one’s own way to board meetings is not a requirement to serve on the board. Nevertheless, whenever possible, board members pay for some of all of their board meeting travel and lodging expenses either directly or through their organization or school. These expenses become tax deductible contributions to CCPH as a 501(c) 3 organization.

We anticipate bringing on these new board members with initial staggered terms of 2-3 years so they do not all rotate off the board at one time. New board members will begin terms at a 2018 CCPH board meeting. Photos and bios for current board members are posted on the [CCPH website](#).

If you are interested in serving on the board and can fulfill the time commitments above, please let us know through a brief email to programs@ccph.info by January 5, 2018. This will help us plan reviews based on the number of applications we anticipate receiving. Completed applications--see the accompanying form--are due no later than **January 19, 2018**. You will be notified of the status of your application by February 16, 2018. Selected applicants will be interviewed by phone in February/March, 2018.
